

# Leyenda

The wine is produced from the best Cabernet Sauvignon grapes harvested in the Chile Central and Maipo Valleys. It is the pure expression of the rich terroir enjoying a southern sunshine and warm Pacific wind.

## TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

**Appellation :** Chile

**Location :** Central Valley and Maipo Valley

**Grape varieties planted:** 70% Syrah, 25% Carignan, 5% Grenache

**Age of the vines :** 15 years

**Planting density :** 3,000-5,000 vines per hectare

**Soil :** clay, sand, granite

**Vineyard management :**

- 2 to 3 meter-spacing between vine rows
- Cordon pruning and trellising
- Grass covering, thinning out of the leaves, parcel-based selection

**Winemaking:**

- Cold maceration
- Thermo-regulated fermentation
- Aging in oak barrels (20%) for 8-12 months

**Average yield :** 70 hl per hectare

## TASTING NOTES

It is fruity and full bodied boasting great aromatic intensity. Supple, ample and well structured in the mouth with red and black fruit flavors and well integrated toasty notes. Pairs well with duck breast, grilled meats, game, lamb.
