Magrez Tivoli's vineyard is located in the town of Saint-Laurent Médoc, which is famous for sheltering the best Crus of the area. The old vines are planted on a soil that is rich in history - the gateway to pilgrims from across the Atlantic and on their way to Saint Jacques de Compostela.

TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Appellation : Médoc

Location : Saint-Laurent Médoc

Area under vines : 2.5 hectares

Grape varieties planted : 80% Cabernet Sauvignon , 20% Merlot

Age of the vines : 45 years

Planting density : 8,000 vines per hectare

Soil: Gravels

Vineyard management :

- Bordeaux pruning
- Grass covering on every row
- Sustainable methods
- Thinning out of the leaves on both sides
- Thinning out of the bunches to remove late ripening grapes

Winemaking :

- Transfer into thermo-regulated wooden tanks of small capacity by gravity
- Manual punching down
- Average maceration time: 28-30 days
- Running off in fine grained new oak barrels
- Aging for 16 months

Harvest dates :

- Merlot 07 october
- Cabernet Sauvignon 13 october

Bottling : June 2015

Production: 3 000 bouteilles
