



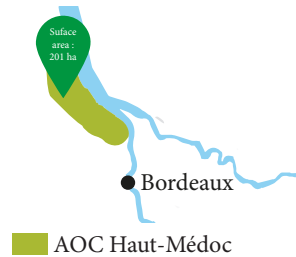
CHÂTEAU LA TOUR CARNET VINTAGE 2022



Nine centuries of history: Château La Tour Carnet dates back to the 12th century, making it the oldest château in the Médoc. The medieval architecture features a tower built in 1120, surrounded by a moat. It's been home to many illustrious owners such as the family of Michel de Montaigne, one of the greatest French philosophers, best known for his "Essays", and twice serving as Mayor of Bordeaux. The very first vines of Château La Tour Carnet were planted in 1409.
