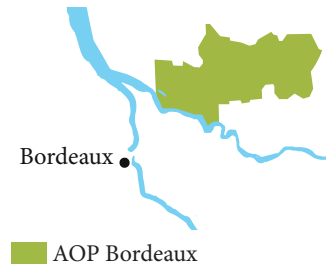

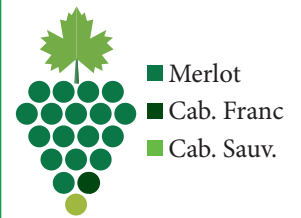

FOOD AND WINE PAIRING



Red meat

TASTING

EYE

Dark, dense colour

NOSE

Notes of red and black fruit

MOUTH

Round wine, silky tannins

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

- Double Guyot pruning
- Natural weed control
- De-leafing to ensure perfect ripening of the grapes

VINIFICATION

- Mechanical sorting of the harvest
- Fermentation in stainless steel vats at 28°C
- Aged for 8 months
