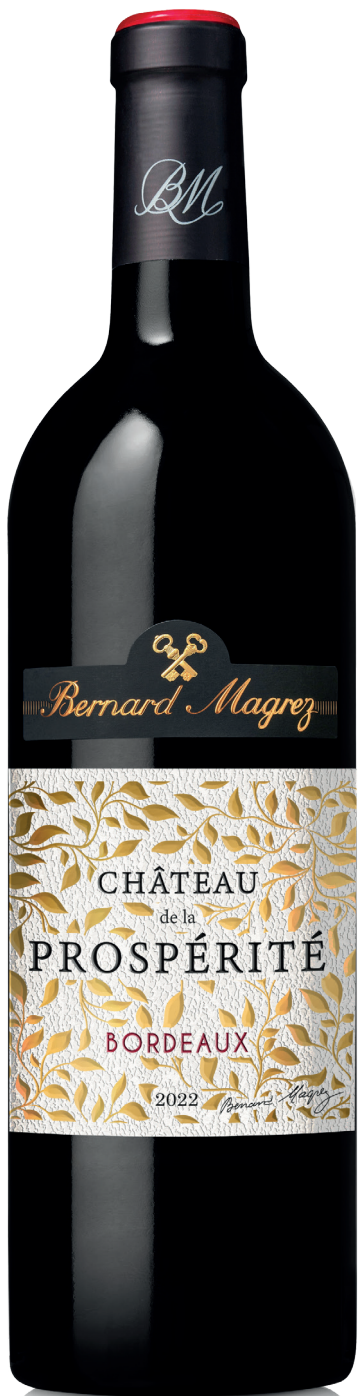


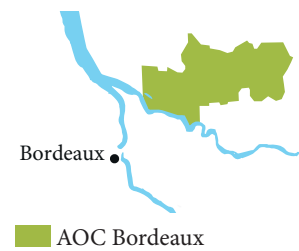


CHÂTEAU DE LA PROSPÉRITÉ

Discover Bernard Magrez's «Château de la Prospérité». This is a predominantly Merlot blend from the south-facing clay-limestone slopes of the village of Les-Artigues-de-Lussac. A brilliant ruby colour, the nose reveals notes of fresh, slightly ripe red fruit (raspberry, blueberry) when aired. Round on the palate, with a wonderfully long, fruity finish. Enjoy it now, or leave it to age so that it can express all its complexity over time.



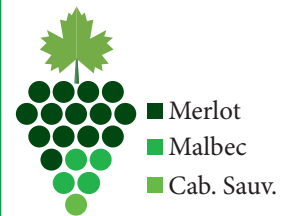

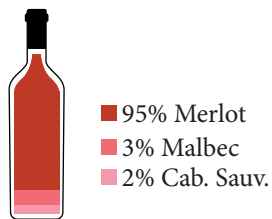

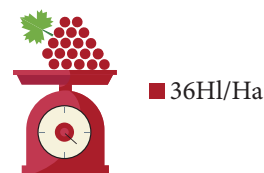

EYE

Purple colour, shiny disc

NOSE

Notes of red and black fruit combined with spicy aromas

MOUTH

A delicious, silky, well-balanced wine

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

- Density of 5,000 vines/ha
- Double Guyot Bordelaise pruning
- Vineyard grassed and worked between the rows
- Cavaillon weeding (chemical and mechanical)
- Integrated protection

VINIFICATION

- Mechanical harvesting
- Selection of parcels
- Maceration for 4 weeks with temperature control
- Traditional ageing in vats
