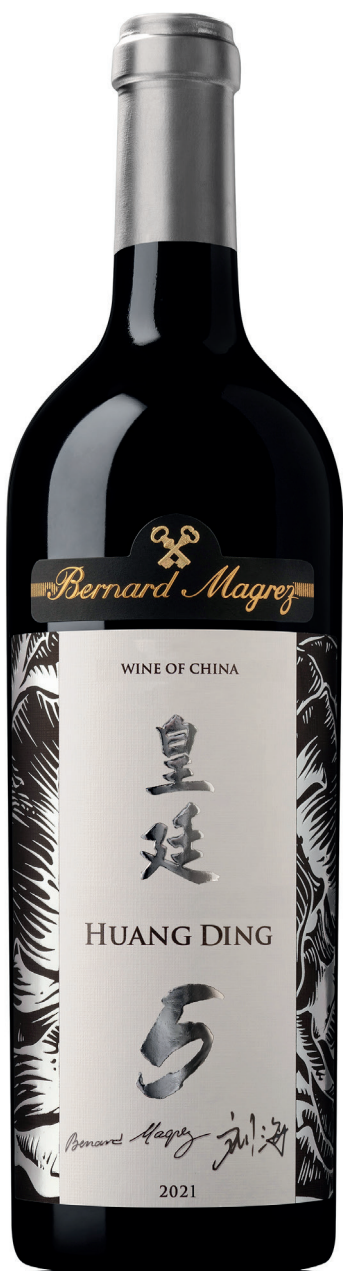




HUANG DING 5

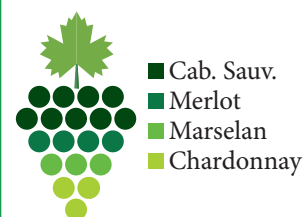

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

- Pruning begins in mid to late October.
- In early to mid-November, the vines are buried for the winter. In March, the vines are dug up. In April, disbudding. Flowering at the end of May. Mid-July, veraison and early October, harvest.

VINIFICATION

- Hand-picked
- Transfer to vats for maceration at 20°C
- Transfer to a stainless steel vat for malolactic fermentation
- Aged for 18 months in barrels
