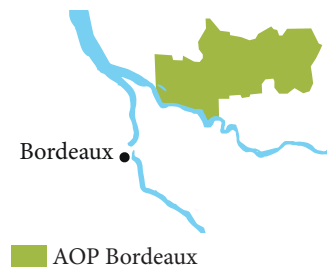




CHÂTEAU JAMAIS RENONCER

Situated 45km east of Bordeaux, on the right bank, the estate lies in the continuity of the Saint-Emilion hillsides on the land of the last battle of the Hundred Years' War, which ended English domination after 300 years of rule, in 1453. The Romans planted the first vines as early as the 2nd century, and Ausone's writings in the 5th century tell us that the wine from this vineyard was renowned as far away as Rome.

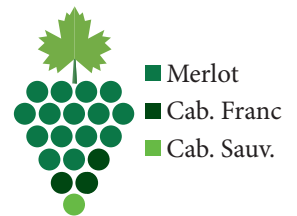

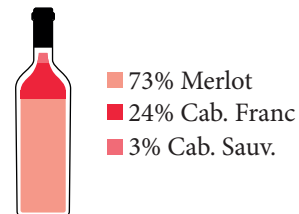

- Guyot pruning
- Controlled natural weeding

VINIFICATION

- Mechanical sorting of the harvest
- Fermentation in stainless steel vats at a maximum temperature of 28°C
- Traditional ageing in vats
