The estate is located in the picturesque area of the Xi Xia royal tombs dating from 1038, in Ningxia, China. In 2021, the estate was classified as a Grands Crus Classés in the eastern wine-growing region of the Helan Mountains, in Ningxia Province.

EYE

Yellow, shiny highlights

NOSE

Tropical fruit, melon and pineapple

MOUTH

Intense aromas of tropical fruits, notably melon and pineapple. French oak enriches the wine with nuances of hazelnut and sesame.

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

- Pruning begins in mid to late October.
- In early to mid-November, the vines are buried for the winter. In March, the vines are dug up. In April, disbudding. Flowering at the end of May. Mid-July, green harvest and end of August, grape harvest.

VINIFICATION

- 15 days at low temperature
- Aged in barrels for 6 months
